The *Territorial Court Act* contemplates the use of mediation, and efforts being made to resolve, by consensus, the issues between the Court and the Government. For example, section 23 provides as follows:

Mediation skills of commission

23 If practicable, at least one commissioner should be skilled in mediation or other consensus processes to resolve differences.

Section 24(2) states:

(2) The commission shall make every effort to use mediation and other consensus processes to resolve differences between the parties.

Finally, section 25(4)(b) reads:

(4) The commission shall

...

(b) employ those consensus processes that the commission considers advisable to assist the government and the judiciary in resolving their differences within 60 days of the commission having been appointed;

As is not uncommon in JCC proceedings in Canada, the parties are in a position where they have agreed upon a Joint Submission, which follows, to be placed before the Commission for approval, if considered appropriate.

1. Holiday pay for Hourly-rated Justice of the Peace

The parties are in agreement that the Commission should recommend that effective April 1, 2010, hourly rated Justices of the Peace receive time and one half pay for all hours

worked on designated paid holidays (as available to Government of Yukon employees), such that their hourly rate for hours worked on those holidays would be as follows:

JP 1: \$45.00 per hour


JP 2: \$52.50 per hour

JP 3 \$82.50 per hour

2. All other benefits

The parties agree that all other terms, benefits, allowances, stipends, etc. in effect for hourly rated Justices of the Peace in the Yukon shall remain unchanged.


