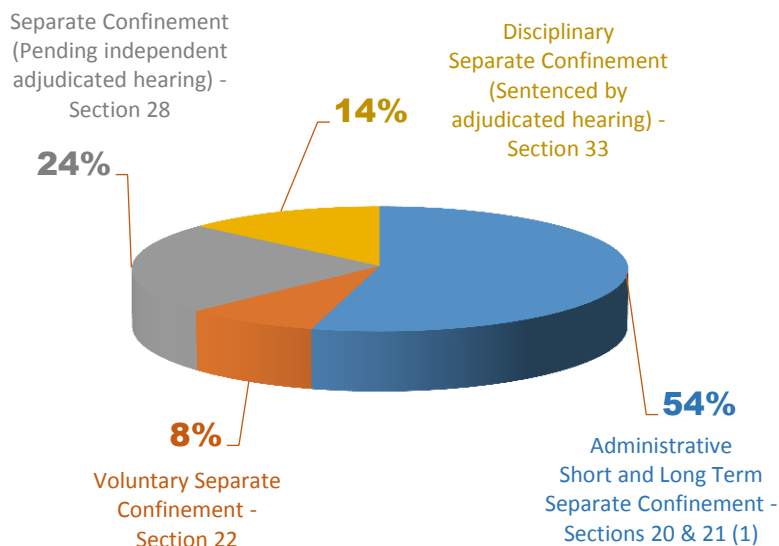


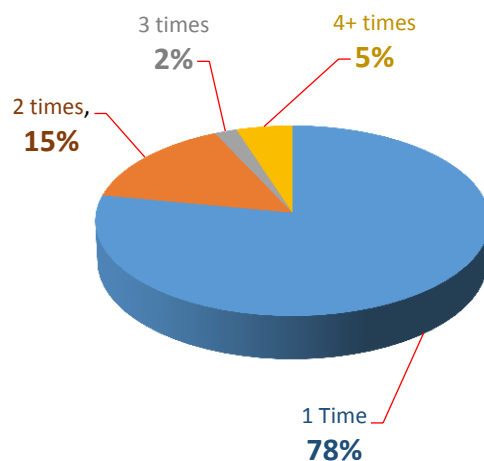


There were 292 individuals incarcerated in 2017 on 446 WCC admissions.
 There were 22,734 bed days in 2017. Of those, 263 (1.2%) were served in the Segregation Unit by 40 individuals.
 3 individuals voluntarily confined themselves in 2017.

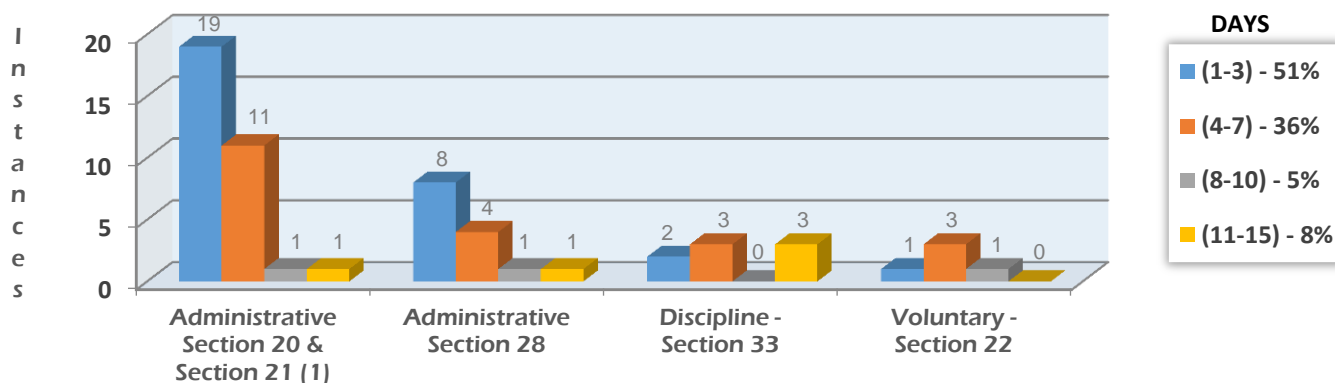
Separate Confinement by Corrections Act and Regulations Section

Under the Corrections Act, separate confinement is defined in sections 20, 21, 22 (voluntary) and 28. Segregation is referred to in section 33 as a disciplinary penalty administered by independent hearing adjudicators. All individuals who are separately confined under the above sections retain access to health services, visitors, legal counsel and elders.
